The **Network** is a group of stories volunteers born within the European project **YoMEM**.

Who are the volunteers?

The **Stories Volunteers** are young people of different ages, nationalities and cultural backgrounds, united by a **passion for life stories** and a desire to enhance the values of a United Europe.

What do the stories volunteers do?

They collect stories related to personal experiences of Europe, such as **"My first experience of Europe"**, or personal experiences of European historical events, and above all stories and experiences of **social change in Europe**, stories that tell us about what needs to be changed, and about what we can do for a **better Europe**.
